## CBA: Resources Overview

The CBA Kit was created in collaboration with Bellevue Public Schools to fulfill the Dig Deep CBA requirement on the topic of 1870-1910: Years of Growth and Change in Washington State. The kit includes several digital resources in addition to the artifacts.

**Document B** Gives the artifact more context in Washington State History and helps show a connection to how Washington has changed over time.
