ABOUT THE BEZOS CENTER FOR INNOVATION

What does innovation look like? Who innovates, where does it happen, and how do great ideas evolve? Discover the creativity and ingenuity of Puget Sound's residents in the *Bezos Center for Innovation*. Explore how innovation shaped our region and changed the world. Through interactive exhibits, community and educational programs, and first-person insights from leading innovators, discover Seattle's role as a nexus of big ideas and new directions - and ignite the innovator within!

What does the Bezos Center for Innovation look like?

The Bezos Center occupies 5,000 square feet in MOHAI's Faye G. Allen Grand Atrium, and features multimedia, interactive and hands-on experiences as well as artifacts, images and oral histories that explore Seattle's culture of innovation.

What is the visitor experience like?

The Bezos Center allows visitors to explore different themes revolving around innovation, including what it means, where it happens, and how to turn creative ideas into useable products. The experience is grounded in the local community, highlighting Seattle's most influential inventions and featuring insights and interviews with Seattle's leading innovators.

Seattleites are known inventors. From dimming windows in the Dreamliner to the sound waves used in the Sonicare toothbrush, the people in the Puget Sound region are entrepreneurs at heart and have boundary-pushing visions.

Throughout the Bezos Center, visitors actively participate in the experience. The Idea Lab invites guests to join a communal collaboration to identify and solve some of today's most pressing challenges. The Seattle Patent Tree provides a three-dimensional history of the Puget Sound region's inventive spirit and check out cutting-edge concepts in What's Next.
